ORDER


Prior to March 30, 2007, the United States trustee shall file a further report with the Court. The report must address whether Money Management International has an employment policy that bars the employment of individuals (or otherwise discriminates with respect to the employment of individuals) who seek to be hired as credit counselors by Money Management International.

The affidavit admitted as exhibit "1" at the March 1, 2007 hearing informs the Court that Money Management International does hire individuals notwithstanding any prior bankruptcy filing. However, it does not specifically address the question of whether Money Management International has in the past and will in the future hire such individuals as credit counselors.

The Court has taken no action with respect to Money Management International's status as an approved credit counselor and has no present intention of taking any such action. At this time, Money Management International is an approved credit counselor in the Southern District of Texas and its properly issued credit counseling certificates are fully valid and must be accepted by the trustees in this District.

The Court will conduct a further status conference on March 30, 2007 at 10:00 a.m. A representative of the United States trustee must appear at the hearing. Other interested parties may, but are not required to, appear. The United States trustee shall provide notice of that hearing to the chapter 7 panel trustees in this District.
